

# FQHR PEDIGREE EXAMPLE

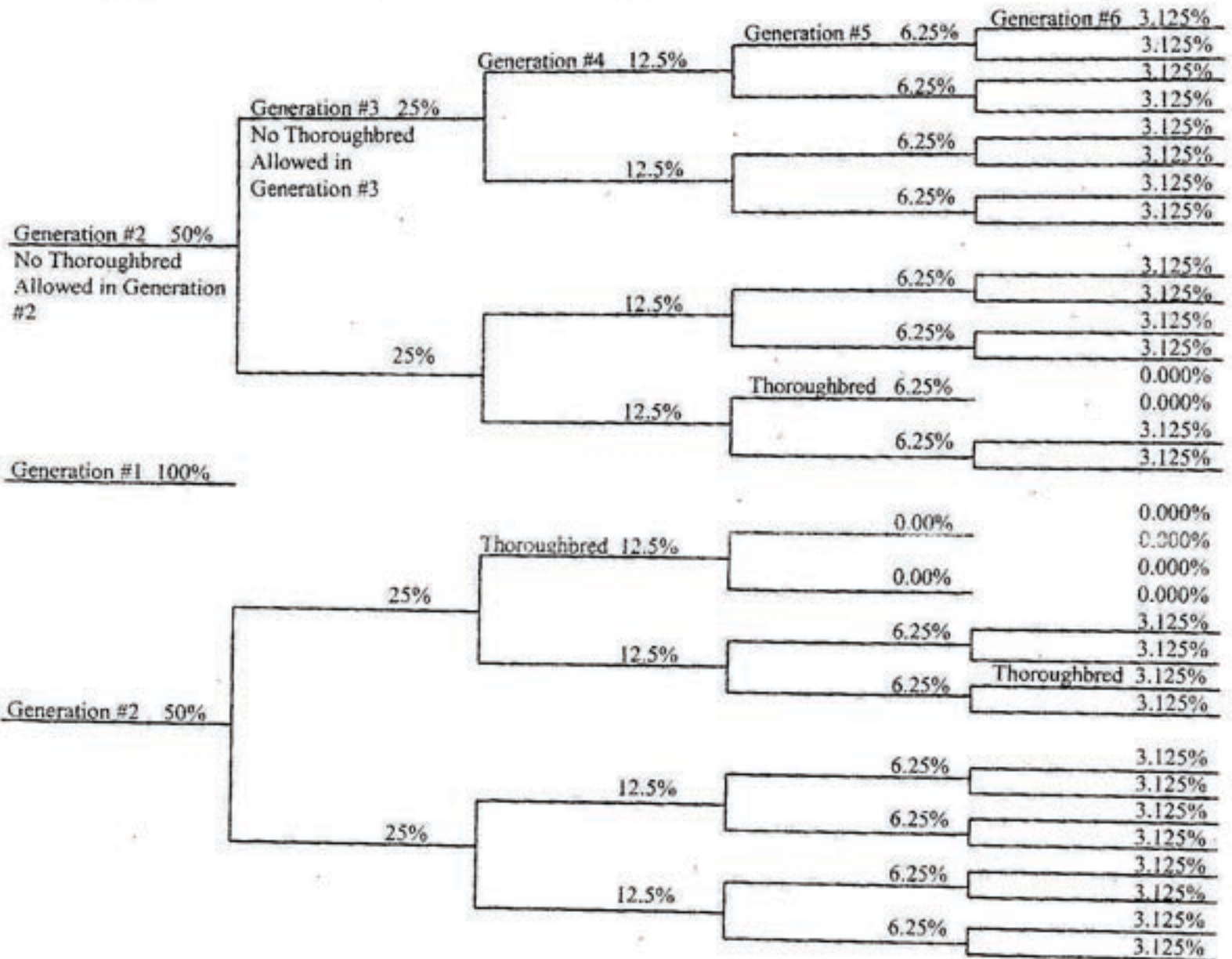

1. Those families known to carry H.Y.P.P. are not eligible for registration regardless of generation.
2. To be eligible for registration, a horse cannot carry more than 25% Thoroughbred blood.
3. No registered Thoroughbred is allowed in the 2nd. or 3rd. generations.
4. The F.Q.H.R recognizes the first 27,000 horses listed by the A.Q.H.A. for registry as Foundation blood. (75%) of the pedigree must descend from, or run to Foundation blood.
5. The horse in the above example is 21.875% Thoroughbred, and is eligible for registration, assuming that no additional TB appears on the other lines in the pedigree that would cause the TB blood to exceed 25%. Only the TB that has been added since or above the 27,000 reg. is discounted.
6. Example horse:  $12.5\% + 6.25\% + 3.125\% = 21.875\%$  Thoroughbred blood.
7. The 7th and 8th generations will be researched when registration numbers are high or thoroughbred blood is in question.
